



Star gazing

To complement our three two-bedroomed cottages we now have an astronomy facility. We have 9.5" Newtonian Reflector telescope. It is sited in a 4-acre field (150 yards from the cottages) with low light pollution. Our 'on-site expert' is Brian sheen, (Roseland Observatory), who by arrangement will give lectures on topics relevant to the time of year.

A peaceful and scenic location, the cottages being at the end of a short lane on a small working farm.

Nobby's Garden



Visitors can stroll on the owners 30 acres of pasture land. 150 yards away is an astronomical telescope for viewing the sky at night, 200 yards away is the farm's spring fed natural lake, where free coarse fishing is in abundance. Each cottage has a garden with a tiled patio area and barbecue, where visitors can relax in peaceful surroundings. We have a small flock of sheep, a famous 3 legged dog named 'Bess' who will greet you on your arrival and 'Boots' the largest cat you will ever see! Bill has lived here all his life, he knows all the best routes, out of the way places, and best pubs in the whole of Cornwall!

Nobby's & Foxy's



Nobby's and Foxy's cottages are semi-detached converted stables in the farmyard. They are 'upside-down houses' – with open plan living-dining areas, and a separated kitchen with every amenity including freezer and automatic washer/dryer. Furnishings are of a high standard. There is full central heating plus a living flame fire. In each there are two bedrooms - one a king size; and one a twin. Each have room for a cot. In Foxy's there is a full size bathroom with separate shower room – in Nobby's there is a full size bathroom with shower unit over the bath. Each have their own private garden, (see opposite) overlooking the valley. (Foxy's has a decked balcony).

Carthouse Cottage

This cottage is a high standard single storey converted carthouse barn. Accommodation comprises: Bedroom 1 has a King size bed. Bedroom 2 has 2 single beds. Bathroom with bath and shower. Beamed open plan living area with feature stone fire place, french windows, colour T.V., video. Kitchen with electric cooker, microwave, small fridge & automatic washing machine. Central Heating plus woodburner in living area (bagged fuel at cost from owner-first bag free). Adjacent parking space for 3 cars.
